The British Sports Car Club's Annual British Car Fest

In July of 1984, a small group of car enthusiasts stood around in a parking lot in Memphis Tennessee rehashing what they liked and disliked about the recent car show they had just attended. That night a dream was born: Why not organize their own show? In less than four months the First Annual British Car Fest premiered on Mud Island, Memphis, Tennessee sponsored by the British Sports Car Club, Ltd. And the rest, as they say, "is history..."

The original organizers were so unsure of that first year's success, they kicked in \$25 each to establish a simple budget. But their vision was clear. They dedicated their efforts to charity, guaranteeing a donation regardless of the actual financial results. As for the British Car Fest itself, these enthusiasts knew exactly what they wanted: To provide a show with something for every British car lover—parties, tours, technical sessions, professional judging, People's Choice awards, trophies, Honorary VIP chairman, and, good old Southern Hospitality.

These goals have remained unchanged. Three years later the British Sports Car Club, Ltd. has a proud and remarkable record:

- Over 425 cars registered (189 in 1986 alone)
- More than 20 separate marques represented
- Representation from 15 states and Canada
- Over \$3,700 in trophies awarded in 22 classes
- Over 500 door prizes given away in three years
- Two completely rebuilt MGBs have been raffled off for \$1.00 per chance
- Over \$25,000 donated to the Variety Club Children's Services of Memphis, Tennessee

And as satisfying as these first three years have been, the future of the Annual British Car Fest is even more exciting. The quality of the past is continually upgraded, and new ideas are constantly discussed, researched and refined. Some of the additional events being considered for 1987 include a Senior's Trophy class, Vintage car racing, VIP guests from the British motor car industry, and much more.

We owe a special debt of gratitude to all corporate sponsors listed throughout this first Commemorative issue. Without their generous support, services, gifts, and financial contributions, none of this would be possible. Our hearts belong especially to every one of you who love British Cars...who come to our shows...who participate in our events. You are the ones who make it all worthwhile and for that we thank you!

Children born with either partial or total absence of a limb, who were once destined to a lifetime of complete dependence on others, can now be fitted with advanced, electronically controlled artificial limbs.

The newest prosthetic devices provide excellent functional return once the recipient has been given training in their use. Among them are battery-operated elbow joints and hands that can perform everyday tasks, controlled by intricate systems that allow their operators to complete more closely with normal children.

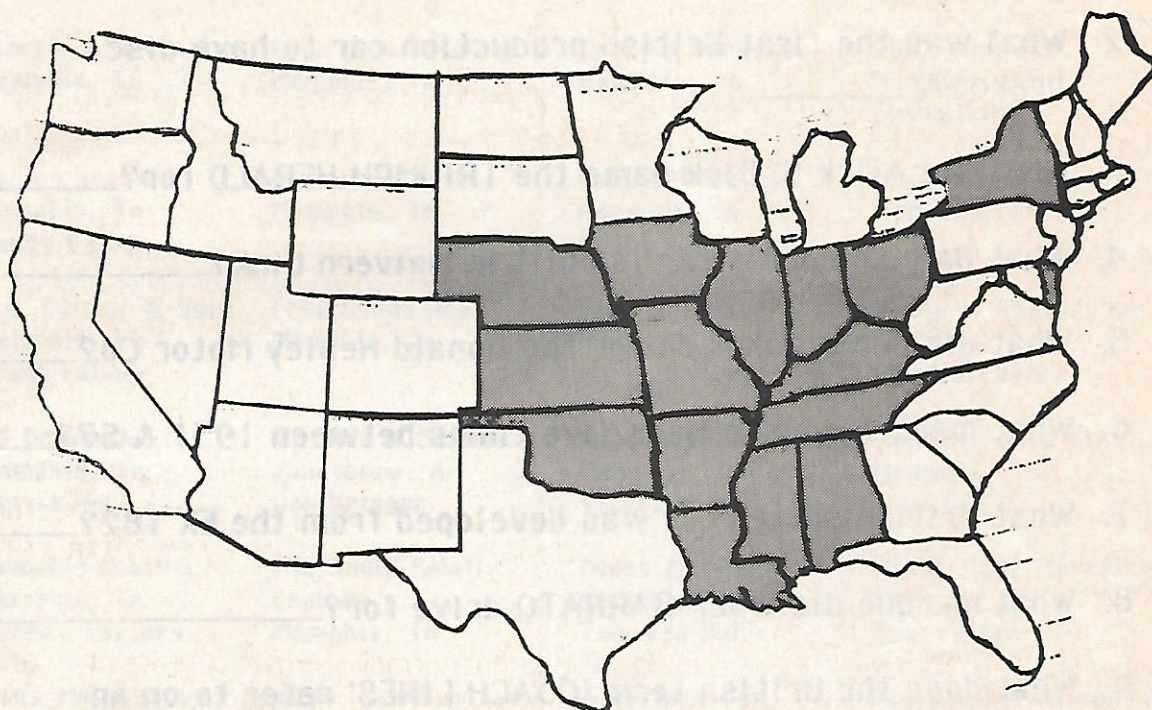
These are very expensive devices. However, to someone observing an armless or legless child both before and after receipt of his man-made limbs, their value is beyond question. **Variety Children's Services Center** provides the devices, and supports the fitting and training of the children in their use. It will also make new and better devices available as they emerge from research laboratories.

Variety also aids the homeless and abused children that nobody seems to care about... Parental neglect is the fate of far too many boys and girls and is often taken for granted by people unwilling or unable to cope with the responsibilities of child care.

Variety sponsors the Child Protection and Adoption Center located at 45 N. Manassas Street in Memphis. In cooperation with the Department of Human Services, **Variety** obtains volunteers and locates foster and adoptive homes for many of the homeless and abused children. A "Needy Children's Fund" is maintained to meet the immediate and special needs of the dependent and neglected children that are brought to the attention of the Center.

Variety is an international organization with a membership consisting of charitable, hard-working, caring and loving people... devoted to helping the handicapped and underprivileged children. Most of these members are business men and women who contribute time, energy and money to plan and implement projects in order to raise money for their **SPECIAL CHILDREN**. **VARIETY** also depends on its many kind and generous friends for help in their continued efforts to support these **IMPORTANT** services to its **SPECIAL** children.
