What makes a car a "Senior"?

Any car with two class wins in previous Fests is considered a "Senior" (unless the most recent win was with a score of under 90 points), allowing those consistent winners to compete against each other in classes ES and LS.

...with the following exceptions....

- Any car scoring less than 90 points in its most recent Fest.
- There are no "Seniors" in the Competition/Modified, New Car, or Motorcycle classes.

Cars may be subject to reclassification if fewer than three cars are present in any category

The Featured Marque for 2006 will be **MG**, so we expect a large turnout of these classic beauties, along with hoards of Jaguars, Triumphs, Healeys, Bentleys, Rolls-Royces and any number of other British marques.

There are a couple of changes to the schedule of events for this year. Early registration will be held in conjunction with the Friday night Hospitality Dinner, which will again be held at the main tent at the show site. 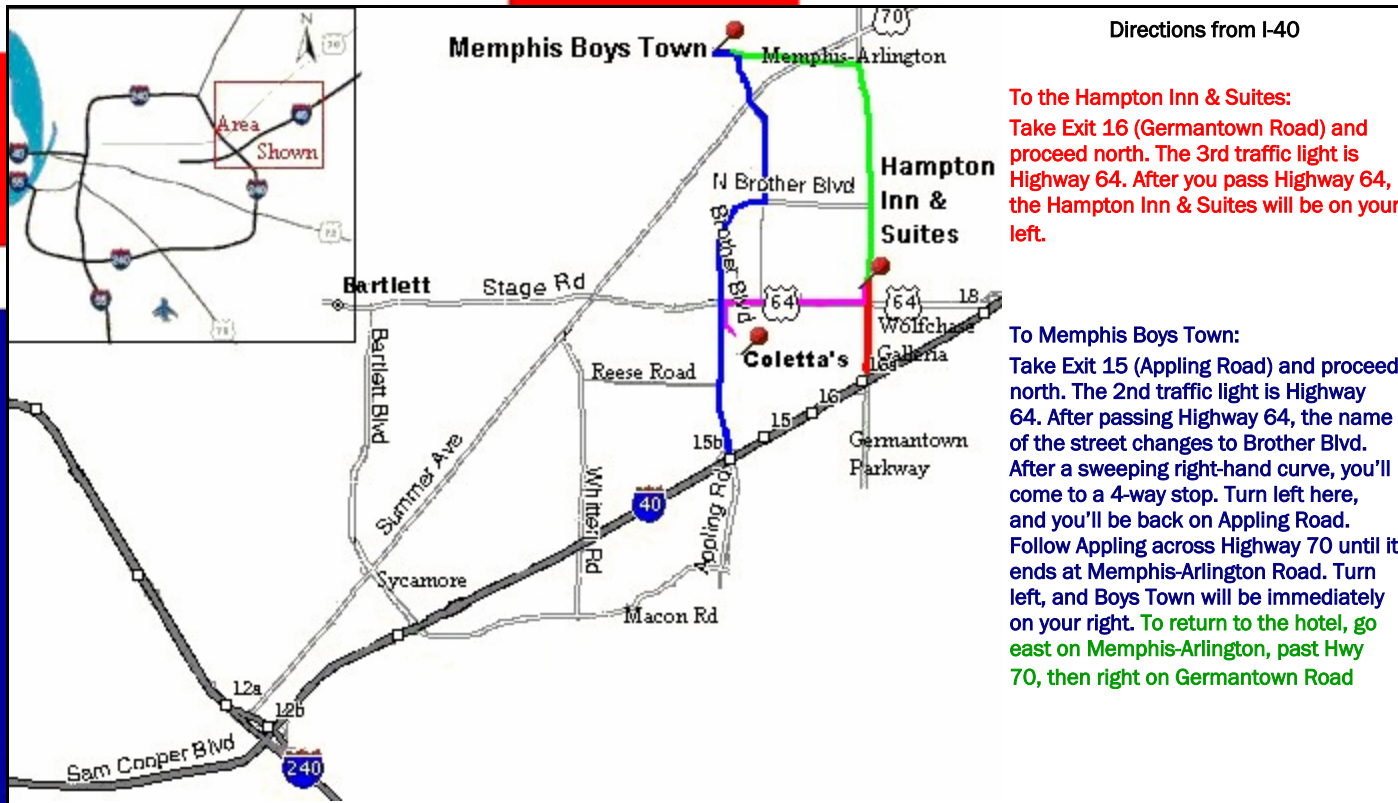

Directions from I-40

To the Hampton Inn & Suites:
 Take Exit 16 (Germantown Road) and proceed north. The 3rd traffic light is Highway 64. After you pass Highway 64, the Hampton Inn & Suites will be on your left.

To Memphis Boys Town:
 Take Exit 15 (Appling Road) and proceed north. The 2nd traffic light is Highway 64. After passing Highway 64, the name of the street changes to Brother Blvd. After a sweeping right-hand curve, you'll come to a 4-way stop. Turn left here, and you'll be back on Appling Road. Follow Appling across Highway 70 until it ends at Memphis-Arlington Road. Turn left, and Boys Town will be immediately on your right. **To return to the hotel, go east on Memphis-Arlington, past Hwy 70, then right on Germantown Road**

A detailed map (with simple directions) giving you the easiest and least congested routes between the Hampton Inn & Suites, Memphis Boys Town and Coletta's Italian Restaurant will be included in your registration packet.
