Tech-niques

Brake dust a problem? Here is a simple cheap and very easy way to help eliminate it. Now that the driving season is here and the miles mount up on our LBC's, brake dust becomes a problem. To reduce the problem of blackened wheels take off the wheel and spray the reverse side (back) of the wheel with PAM cooking spray, you will be amazed how effective it is. If you wish to clean it off just use hot water and washing detergent. Dawn dish washing liquid works the best at cutting grease.
