# The Lighter Side


Stumpy and his wife Martha went to the State Fair every year. Every year Stumpy would say, "Martha, I'd like to ride in that airplane." And

# Tech-niques

<u>Wiper Blades</u> - How many windscreens have you seen with an arc engraved in the glass by defective wiper blades? Wiper blades for the MGB (10") and Spridget (9") are both expensive and difficult to find. A refill solution is available from Bosch. Part number 43111 is an 11" refill blade and will fit the MG and Austin wiper assemblies. By using the metal end clip in the package, the refill will slide easily into the metal frame and the excess length can be cut off as required.

Bosch also makes wiper refills in 13" through 20", so no matter what the length of the wiper blades on your English car, you can probably find one to fit and these rubber refills are much cheaper than the replacement assemblies from our favorite catalogue parts vendors.

I have a hint for MG car and probably other marque owners.

If you have had one of those funny long round light bulbs burn out and thought you had to mail order a .95 cent replacement out of a catalogue and pay shipping and wait, you don't have to. They can be purchased from an Auto Zone or similar type store. I have found two brands available. Sylvania #6418 (C5W) and GE #C5W (6418). They come two in a bubble pack and sell for around \$2.00. These bulbs are used as license plate, map, and trunk lights in MGB's and Midgets and also roof lamps in MGC's. They are not the correct size for backup lights or 1977-80 MGB map liahts.
