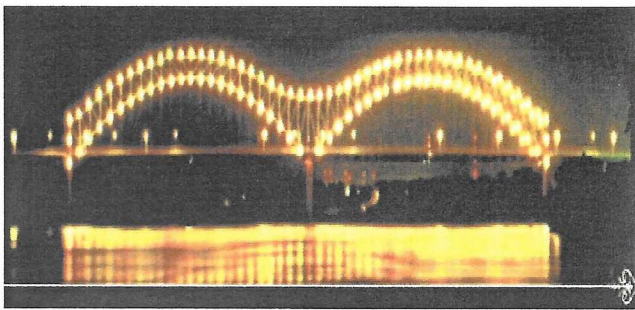

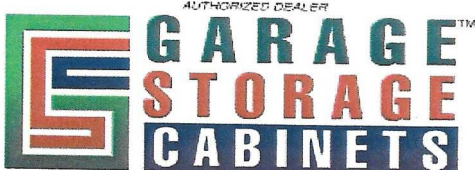


Monthly Club Meeting

Senior's Special

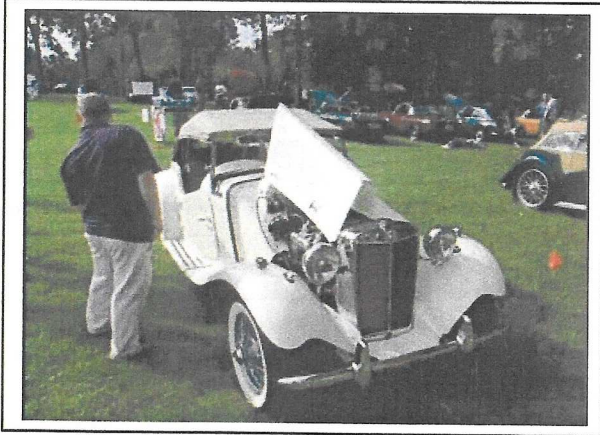
We went to breakfast at a restaurant where the "seniors' special" was two eggs, bacon, hash browns and toast for \$1.99.

"Raw and in the shell," my wife replied. She took the two eggs home...

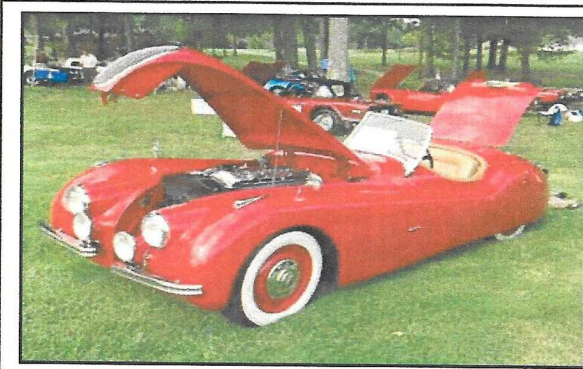
